Thirsty? Choose Water! is a whole-school approach to promoting water. The resources below have been created for and used by NSW Stage 4 students.

ONLINE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT

Thirsty? Choose Water! promotes water as the drink of choice at school. This includes the below key strategies. Consider how these would apply in your school.

- Chilled water station installation
 - See <u>Fundraising Pack</u> for purchase and installation considerations.
- School policy e.g. water bottles available in class, encourage 'water only' on excursion notes,
- <u>NSW Healthy School Canteen Strategy</u>

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5 STEPS TO MAKE A SPLASH IN YOUR SCHOOL!

1. WHAT'S HAPPENING?

Consider what's happening in your school and how you can support students to choose water!

- What are students drinking at school?
- What do staff drink at school? Role modelling can help students choose water!

2. DOES YOUR SCHOOL HAVE?

- A chilled water station or access to bottle refill stations
- A School Policy that supports students to choose water at school and during events
- A range of communication channels where water can be promoted
- Access to healthy drinks at school. Is your canteen meeting the NSW Healthy School Canteen Strategy? Are there vending machines at school?

3. WHAT NEXT?

List the key actions that would need to occur to start *Thirsty? Choose Water!* in your school *e.g.*

- Engage P&C to start fundraising
- PDHPE teacher training
- Delegate social media scheduling
